TAIHS Outreach Clinic

From July 2015, TAIHS will provide a primary health clinic at Eventide Residential Facility, Charters Towers.

Our Model of Care

- We are a bulk-billed primary health service, so patients can access the service free of charge
- We are accredited under the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) Standards, so clients know they will receive a high quality of service.
- We have been providing primary health care services to Aboriginal, Torres Strait Islander and non-Indigenous clients since 1974.
- We deliver holistic, comprehensive, and culturally appropriate health care to the Aboriginal, Torres Strait Islander and non-Indigenous communities where we operate.
- Our integrated primary health care model aligns to the philosophy of community control, and the comprehensive and inclusive view of health that this entails. This involves seeing health as more than just physical well-being; it acknowledges the significance of social, emotional and cultural factors as determinants of overall health and well-being.

Days and Hours of Operation

- Charters Towers clinic will be provided every Wednesday and Thursdays.
- Clinic will operate from 8.30am – 4.30pm
- Transport will also be available to patients to and from the clinic.
